PERSONAL EXPLANATION

Mr. ABERCROMBIE. Mr. Speaker, this afternoon, I was unavoidably detained by a Hawaii Congressional delegation meeting with the Secretary of Interior, and I consequently was unable to vote on three recorded votes. Had I been present, I would have voted as follows: Rollcall 120, to pass H.R. 2328, to re-authorize the Clean Lakes Program—“yes”; rollcall 121, to pass H.R. 3039, Chesapeake Bay water restoration—“yes”; rollcall 122, to pass H.R. 2884, to extend the Strategic Petroleum Reserve program—“yes.”

Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring), That when the House adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, April 13, 2000, or Friday, April 14, 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 2, 2000, for morning-hour debate, or until noon on the second day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, April 13, 2000, or Friday, April 14, 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesdays, April 25, 2000, or such time on that day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

REPORT ON RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 3439, RADIO BROADCASTING PRESERVATION ACT OF 2000

Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, submitted a privileged report (Rept. No. 106-575) on the resolution (H. Res. 472) providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3439) to prohibit the Federal Communications Commission from establishing rules authorizing the operation of new, low power FM radio stations, which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed.

REPORT ON RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 4199, DATE CERTAIN TAX CODE REPLACEMENT ACT

Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, submitted a privileged report (Rept. No. 106-576) on the resolution (H. Res. 473) providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4199) to terminate the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, which was
