Mr. Speaker, pursuant to House Resolution 645, I call up the bill (H.R. 2728) to amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 to provide for adjudicative flexibility with regard to an employer filing of a notice of contest following the issuance of a citation by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, and ask for its immediate consideration in the House.

The Clerk read the title of the bill.

The SPEAKER pro tempore (Mr. TERRY). Pursuant to House Resolution 645, the bill is considered read for amendment.

The text of H.R. 2728 is as follows:

H.R. 2728

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Occupational Safety and Health Small Business Day in Court Act of 2003".

SEC. 2. CONTESTING CITATIONS UNDER THE OC-CUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT.

(a) CITATION.—The second sentence of section 10(a) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 659(a)) is amended by inserting "(unless such failure results from mistake, inadvertence, surprise, or excusable neglect)" after "assessment of penalty".
