### LOBBYING TRANSPARENCY ACT OF 2007—Continued

Mr. CONYERS. Madam Speaker, pursuant to the instructions of the House on the motion to recommit, I report the bill, H.R. 2317, back to the House with an amendment.

The SPEAKER pro tempore. The Clerk will report the amendment.

The Clerk read as follows:

Amendment offered by Mr. SMITH of Texas: In section 5(d)(6)(C) of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995, as proposed to be added by section 2(a) of the bill, insert after “leadership PAC,” the following: “a multi-candidate political committee described in section 315(a)(4) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a(a)(4)).”

The SPEAKER pro tempore. The question is on the amendment.

The amendment was agreed to.

The SPEAKER pro tempore. The question is on the engrossment and third reading of the bill.

The bill was ordered to be engrossed and read a third time, and was read the third time.

The SPEAKER pro tempore. The question is on the passage of the bill.

The question was taken; and the Speaker pro tempore announced that the ayes appeared to have it.

Mr. SMITH of Texas. Mr. Speaker, on that I demand the yeas and nays.

The yeas and nays were ordered.
