## BETTER ONLINE TICKET SALES ACT OF 2016

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Better Online Ticket Sales Act of 2016" or the "BOTS Act of 2016"

## SEC. 2. UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE ACTS AND PRAC-TION OF TICKET ACCESS CONTROL MEASURES. TICES RELATING TO CIRCUMVEN-

(a) CONDUCT PROHIBITED.-

(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in paragraph (2), it shall be unlawful for any person-
