AMERICAN TROOPS IN POLAND

Mr. WILSON of South Carolina. Madam Speaker, this past week was a tremendous success for the Polish-U.S. Alliance. U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo sealed a defense cooperation agreement Saturday with Polish officials that will pave the way to deploy more American troops to Poland. President Donald Trump has fulfilled promises made, promises kept, to protect the citizens of Poland discouraging Putin threats.

Pompeo signed the deal with Polish Defense Minister Mariusz Blaszczak that sets out the legal framework for the additional troops.

The agreement would also further other aspects of U.S.-Polish cooperation primarily in investment and trade ties.

Poland has agreed to construct multiple facilities to support more U.S. troops operating in that country. Some 4,500 U.S. troops are currently based in Poland, but about 1,000 more are to be added. President Andrezej Duda of Poland has proudly cited this could be named Fort Trump.

The pact signed Saturday supplements NATO efforts, and allows for the enhancement and modernization of existing capabilities and facilities by allowing U.S. forces to access additional Polish military installations. It also sets out a formula for sharing the logistical and infrastructure costs of an expanded U.S. presence in the country.

This complements additional NATO troops to be stationed in the Baltic Republics of Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania. These German, French, and British assets reinforce the vibrancy of NATO to deter Putin aggression with peace through strength.

It is especially meaningful as we sadly remember the infamous Nazi and Soviet invasion of Poland on September 1, 1939, which

was schemed by the Molotov Ribbentrop Pact, leading to killing millions of Poles, the Holocaust, and the Katyn Forest massacre of 22,000 Polish military, scholars, law enforcement, and security personnel by Soviet Red Army troops.

PAKISTAN SANCTIONS TALIBAN

Mr. WILSON of South Carolina. Madam Speaker, the Associated Press reports today that Pakistan issued sweeping financial sanctions against Afghanistan's Taliban.

Prime Minister Imran Khan has taken bold action to protect the people of Pakistan. I personally still cherish my visits to Islamabad including attending the joint U.S. Marine-Pakistan relief efforts at the earthquake in Muzaffarabad.

President Donald Trump has successfully supported the Financial Action Task Force in Paris, which monitors money laundering and tracks terrorist groups.

The orders, which were made public late on Friday, identified dozens of individuals, including the Taliban's chief peace negotiator Abdul Ghani Baradar and several members of the Haqqani family, including Sirajuddin, the current head of the Haqqani network and deputy head of the Taliban.

As well as the Taliban, the orders also target al-Qaida and the Islamic State affiliate which has carried out deadly attacks in both Pakistan and Afghanistan.

They also take aim at outlawed Pakistani groups like Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP),
