S. 3897

At the request of Mr. GRASSLEY, the names of the Senator from Minnesota (Ms. KLOBUCHAR), the Senator from North Carolina (Mr. TILLIS), the Senator from Hawaii (Ms. HIRONO), the Senator from Connecticut (Mr. BLUMENTHAL), the Senator from California (Mr. PADILLA), the Senator from Vermont (Mr. WELCH) and the Senator from New Jersey (Mr. BOOKER) were added as cosponsors of S. 3897, a bill to revise administrative procedures relating to public safety officers' death benefits, and for other purposes.

S. 3966

At the request of Mr. GRASSLEY, his name and the names of the Senator from Illinois (Mr. DURBIN), the Senator from South Carolina (Mr. GRAHAM), the Senator from Florida (Mrs. MOODY), the Senator from North Carolina (Mr. TILLIS), the Senator from Louisiana (Mr. KENNEDY), the Senator from Delaware (Mr. COONS), the Senator from Hawaii (Ms. HIRONO), the Senator from Connecticut (Mr. BLUMENTHAL), the Senator from California (Mr. PADILLA) and the Senator from New Jersey (Mr. BOOKER) were added as cosponsors of S. 3966, a bill to prohibit the enforcement of certain contractual clauses that restrict disclosure of sexual abuse of minors, and for other purposes.

S. 4189

At the request of Mrs. SHAHEEN, the names of the Senator from Virginia (Mr. KAINE) and the Senator from West Virginia (Mrs. CAPITO) were added as cosponsors of S. 4189, a bill to reduce the price of insulin and provide for pa-

tient protections with respect to the cost of insulin.

S. 4281

At the request of Mr. RICKETTS, the names of the Senator from Indiana (Mr. BANKS) and the Senator from Massachusetts (Ms. WARREN) were added as cosponsors of S. 4281, a bill to provide for export restrictions on certain semiconductor manufacturing equipment and components therefor, and for other purposes.

S. 4378

At the request of Ms. ERNST, the name of the Senator from Alabama (Mrs. BRITT) was added as a cosponsor of S. 4378, a bill to combat fraud in Federal programs, and for other purposes.

S. 4394

At the request of Mr. GRASSLEY, the names of the Senator from Minnesota (Ms. KLOBUCHAR), the Senator from North Carolina (Mr. TILLIS), the Senator from Hawaii (Ms. HIRONO), the Senator from Connecticut (Mr. BLUMENTHAL), the Senator from California (Mr. PADILLA), the Senator from Vermont (Mr. WELCH) and the Senator from Texas (Mr. CRUZ) were added as cosponsors of S. 4394, a bill to amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to improve the COPS program with respect to training command-level personnel, and for other purposes.

S. 4540

At the request of Mrs. MURRAY, the name of the Senator from New Mexico (Mr. HEINRICH) was added as a cosponsor of S. 4540, a bill to amend the Public Health Service Act to improve reproductive health care of individuals with disabilities.

S.J. RES. 182

At the request of Mr. KAINE, the name of the Senator from Colorado

(Mr. BENNET) was added as a cosponsor of S.J. Res. 182, a joint resolution providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the rule submitted by the Department of Education relating to "William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan (Direct Loan) Program".

S. RES. 236

At the request of Mr. GRASSLEY, the name of the Senator from Michigan (Mr. PETERS) was added as a cosponsor of S. Res. 236, a resolution calling for the return of abducted Ukrainian children before finalizing any peace agreement to end the war against Ukraine.

S. RES. 727

At the request of Mrs. FISCHER, the name of the Senator from Arkansas (Mr. BOOZMAN) was added as a cosponsor of S. Res. 727, a resolution supporting the designation of May 29, 2026, as "Mental Health Awareness in Agriculture Day" to raise awareness around mental health in the agricultural industry and workforce and to continue to reduce stigma associated with mental illness.

S. RES. 734

At the request of Mr. WYDEN, the name of the Senator from New Jersey (Mr. BOOKER) was added as a cosponsor of S. Res. 734, a resolution designating May 16, 2026, as "Kids to Parks Day".

S. RES. 737
