## Approval and Promulgation of Implementation Plans; Ohio

**AGENCY:** Environmental Protection

Agency (EPA).

**ACTION:** Proposed rule.

SUMMARY: On September 27, 2003, Ohio submitted proposed revisions to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) for several counties in Ohio, along with a request for redesignation of Cuyahoga County to attainment for SO<sub>2</sub>. In general, the submitted rules are at least equivalent to limitations originally promulgated by EPA in a Federal Implementation Plan (FIP) for the area. Therefore, EPA proposes to approve these revisions to the SIP. In conjunction with this action, EPA proposes to rescind the federally promulgated emission limitations for SO<sub>2</sub> for these counties.

EPA also proposes to redesignate Cuyahoga County to attainment for SO<sub>2</sub>. In association with this proposal, EPA proposes to approve Ohio's plan for continuing to attain the SO<sub>2</sub> standard in Cuyahoga County.
