contained an error. Specifically, the table on page 2539 mistakenly listed one of the priority 1 Continuums of Care (CoCs) as list “KS–501 as Kansas City/Independence/Lee’s Summit/Jackson County CoC.” This document corrects the error by replacing, on line 42 of the table, “Kansas City/Independence/Lee’s Summit/Jackson County CoC” with “Kansas City/Wyandotte CoC” in the second column.
