Apr. 1, 1996  
[H.R. 1787]

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to repeal the saccharin notice requirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. NOTICE REQUIREMENT REPEAL.**

Section 403 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 343) is amended by striking paragraph (p).
