An Act

To redesignate the Dunning Post Office in Chicago, Illinois, as the “Roger P. McAuliffe Post Office”.

Aug. 20, 1996

[H.R. 3834]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

The Dunning Post Office, located at 6441 West Irving Park Road, Chicago, Illinois, shall be redesignated and known as the “Roger P. McAuliffe Post Office”.

**SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United States to the United States Post Office referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Roger P. McAuliffe Post Office”.
