An Act

To authorize appropriations for the National Historical Publications and Records
Commission for fiscal years 1998, 1999, 2000, and 2001.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE NATIONAL
HISTORICAL PUBLICATIONS AND RECORDS COMMISSION.**

Section 2504(f)(1) of title 44, United States Code, is amended—
(1) in subparagraph (F) by striking out “and” after the
semicolon;

(2) in subparagraph (G) by striking out the period and
inserting in lieu thereof a semicolon; and

(3) by adding at the end the following new subparagraphs:

“(H) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;

“(I) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1999;

“(J) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2000; and

“(K) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2001.”.
