Appointing the day for the convening of the first session of the One Hundred
Sixth Congress.

*Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the first
regular session of the One Hundred Sixth Congress shall begin
at noon on Wednesday, January 6, 1999.
