To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service at 410 North 6th Street in Garden City, Kansas, as the “Clifford R. Hope Post Office”.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

The facility of the United States Postal Service located at 410 North 6th Street in Garden City, Kansas, is hereby designated as the “Clifford R. Hope Post Office”.

**SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

Any reference in any law, regulation, map, document, paper, or other record of the United States to the facility referred to in section 1 shall be considered to be a reference to the “Clifford R. Hope Post Office”.
