## An Act

To designate the bridge on United States Route 231 that crosses the Ohio River between Maceo, Kentucky, and Rockport, Indiana, as the “William H. Natcher Bridge”.

Oct. 13, 2000  
[H.R. 1162]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

The bridge on United States Route 231 that crosses the Ohio River between Maceo, Kentucky, and Rockport, Indiana, shall be known and designated as the “William H. Natcher Bridge”.

**SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United States to the bridge referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “William H. Natcher Bridge”.
