An Act

To extend for 6 additional months the period for which chapter 12 of title 11,
United States Code, is reenacted.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.

Section 149 of title I of division C of Public Law 105-277 is amended— 11 USC 1201 *et seq.*, 1201 note.

- (1) by striking “April 1, 1999” each place it appears and inserting “October 1, 1999”;
- (2) in subsection (a)—
 - (A) by striking “September 30, 1998” and inserting “March 31, 1999”; and
 - (B) by striking “October 1, 1998” and inserting “April 1, 1999”; and
- (3) by striking subsection (c).

SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The amendments made by section 1 shall take effect on April 1, 1999. 11 USC 1201 note.
