To designate a Federal building in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, as the "Ronald Reagan Federal Building".

May 7, 2004 [S. 2043]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. RONALD REAGAN FEDERAL BUILDING.

- (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building located at 228 Walnut Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the "Ronald Reagan Federal Building".

 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United States to the building
- referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the Ronald Reagan Federal Building.
