SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Medical Services
for Children Reauthorization Act of 2024”.

**SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF GRANTS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL
SERVICES FOR CHILDREN.**

Section 1910(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
300w–9(d)) is amended by striking “and \$22,334,000 for each of
fiscal years 2020 through 2024” and inserting “\$22,334,000 for
each of fiscal years 2020 through 2024, and \$24,334,000 for each
of fiscal years 2025 through 2029”.
