To extend for 9 additional months the period for which chapter 12 of title 11,
United States Code, is reenacted.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.

Section 149 of title I of division C of Public Law 105-277,
as amended by Public Law 106-5, is amended—

(1) by striking “October 1, 1999” each place it appears
and inserting “July 1, 2000”; and

(2) in subsection (a)—

(A) by striking “March 31, 1999” and inserting “Sep-
tember 30, 1999”; and

(B) by striking “April 1, 1999” and inserting “October
1, 1999”.

SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.
