To amend the Anadromous Fish Conservation Act to include fish in Lake Champlain that ascend streams to spawn.

Anadromous Fish
Conservation Act,
amendment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Anadromous Fish Conservation Act, as amended (16 U.S.C. 757a-f), is amended by inserting immediately after the words "Great Lakes", wherever they appear therein, the words "and Lake Champlain".
