Public Bills and Resolutions Introduced: 28 public bills, H.R. 8842–8869; and 7 resolutions, H. Con. Res. 102; and H. Res. 1293–1298 were introduced. **Pages H3549–51**

Report Filed: A report was filed today as follows:

H.R. 8845, making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, Science, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2027, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 119–652). **Page H3549**

Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2027: The House passed H.R. 8469, making appropriations for military construction, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2027, by a yea-and-nay vote of 400 yeas to 15 nays, Roll No. 175. Consideration began yesterday, May 14th. **Pages H3537–41**

Agreed to:

Perry (No. 29 printed in part B of H. Rept. 119–648) that increases and decreases Veterans Health Administration, Medical Services, by \$1 million for furnishing Stellate Ganglion Block (SGB) therapy to personnel who elect to receive the treatment; and **Pages H3537–38**

Steube (No. 49 printed in part B of H. Rept. 119–648) that prohibits funds from being used to close the Port Charlotte VA Clinic in Port Charlotte, FL. **Page H3538**

Rejected:

Steube (No. 50 printed in part B of H. Rept. 119–648) that sought to redirect \$481,832,000 from the NATO Security Investment Program to Military Construction Defense-Wide (by a recorded vote of 80 yeas to 333 noes, Roll No. 174). **Pages H3538–40**

H. Res. 1275, the rule providing for consideration was agreed to Wednesday, May 13th.

Meeting Hour: Agreed by unanimous consent that when the House adjourns today, it adjourn to meet at noon on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 for morning-hour debate. **Pages H3541**
